Synthèse des jugements individuels Individual judgments' overview

42 siamese, balinese, oriental long- and shorthair were presents.

My overall impression was that the cats were in great condition, clean and well presented and of very nice character in general.

I was happy with the general quality in type, size and colours, and was VERY impressed by one of the breeder groups of which the eldest cat was 7 years of age, a super seal point colourwise, who produced a spectacular 4 years old daughter with deep seal points, all regular developed in colour, lovely deer coloured even body colour and the one and only true eye colour for siamese: DEEP, VIOLET BLUE!! The third generation of this group showed a seal tabby point, stunning in type, exceptional in point colour again, with lovely deep blue eyes who ended up as best female. An ebony with the best coat ever, super tight and very short and glossy, and a bicouleur black and white. This group was shown in excellent condition, super bodie shapes and firm muscle tone, strong and athletic, well balanced and harmonious.

The selection of siamese overall was very good, with one or two exceptions, where it was obviously one line in which eye colour was not paid attention to.

The oriental shorthair overall, were of excellent quality, especially a brown tabby with the only true colour a brown tabby should have: a warm brown base colour with jet black markings. He was best male, best shorthair and best in the top 10. This cat should be an example to breed towards. His colour I have only seen in the very beginning of this variety, many, many years ago.

Lovely examples of the breed in general, with one or two exceptions were the presented cats were too small - attention needs to be paid to the fact that - refined as the standard calls for - does not mean small or skinny. A beautiful cat is always only beautiful when it radiates health, muscle tone, is clean and has good weight to the body.

Very impressed by a black tabby veteran of 10 years. Strong, healthy and of excellent type. He was best Veteran, Best Honour class and ended up in the top 10.

4 cats presented in overall good condition. Very well cared for, with in some case a bit to much weight.

The chocolate Mandarin 8+ years, was overall well balances, if not a tad too heavy, great coat length in very good show condition. A warm chocolate colour in tone, slight undercoat. Good te, with modest but balanced wedge, fitting the overall cat.
